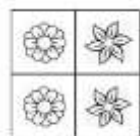

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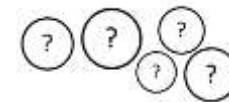

Art

Creating flowers from shapes

What different shapes can you find in your house? You could draw round some objects. Can you make some flowers from using these shapes?



DT

Lots of people grow different fruit and vegetables in their garden. Have you grown anything in yours? If not what fruit and vegetables can you find in your kitchen? Ask an adult to help you to see if you can safely chop a fruit or vegetable, peel one or even grate one. Can you make an interesting picture with the food?



Science

Chitting & Growing Potatoes



Place a potato somewhere warm and light. You could put it in an egg box to stop it rolling away.

Watch what happens over the next 2 weeks.

Record what happens to your potato – you could use drawings.

After 2 weeks, your potato should have shoots about 2-3cm long and will be ready for planting in your garden, in a big tub or a bag full of compost.

Who can grow the biggest / most potatoes?
